**ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL - ACA: Today - Follow-Up Weekend.**

**LENTEN MASS SCHEDULE:** Is as follows: **Monday through Friday at 8:00 a.m. Stations of the Cross with Deacon Joe Trujillo on Friday's at 7:00 p.m.**

**LENTEN REGULATIONS:** Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday, are to abstain from meat on **ALL FRIDAYS** of Lent, including Good Friday. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, and until your 59th birthday, are to fast on Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain one's strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**SPECIAL LITURGICAL NOTES:** Ritual Masses are prohibited during Holy Week and on Sundays of Lent. Funeral Masses may **NOT** be celebrated during the Triduum and on Sundays of Lent. If a marriage is celebrated during Lent, it is to reflect the special nature of the season.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Immaculate Conception Parish in Tome, will be having a Pre-Cana class on Friday and Saturday, March 2nd and 3rd. All couples who are preparing for the Sacrament of Marriage and who need to take a Pre-Cana class are welcomed to attend. The class will begin on Friday evening and continue all day Saturday.
