**ASH WEDNESDAY- FEBRUARY 6TH:** Mass schedule is as follows: 8:00 a.m.; 12:10 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. in Peralta. Communion Service - 5:00 p.m. with Deacon Eddie at Sangre de Cristo.

**LENTEN REGULATIONS:** Catholics are obligated to **FAST on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** Catholics who are 18 to 59 years old are required to keep a limited fast, that is, to eat a single normal meal and have lesser meals, as long as they do not add up to a second meal, (and **NO** food in between). Children are not required to fast. Those with medical conditions requiring greater or more food intake are dispensed from this requirement. Catholics are also required to **abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent.** This applies to Catholics who are 14 years or older. A person with special dietary needs may be dispensed from this requirement. Prayer, fasting and charitable giving are hallmarks of Catholics who enter into the season of Lent to prepare for the renewal of their baptismal commitment at Easter. In addition to what the Church requires, consider how you will prepare for Easter renewal this Lenten season.

**LENTEN WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE:** Will remain the same - Monday; 6:00 p.m.; Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; 8:00 a.m. & Friday; Communion Service.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS:** Friday's 7:00 p.m. in Peralta.
