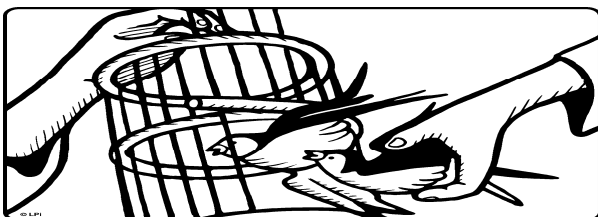
CONFESSIONS - SATURDAY FROM 4:00 - 5:00 P.M. OR BY APPOINTMENT

MARRIAGES

Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date.

BAPTISMS

Parents must arrange the Baptism of their child in advance in the parish office, and all necessary paperwork must be completed by the 1st week of the month. By diocesan regulation, parents must be **REGISTERED FOR THREE MONTHS** and together with the sponsors must attend **ONE** instruction in preparation for Baptism. Sponsors **MUST** be registered and active in a parish; married in the Catholic Church; and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST SATURDAY** of every month - 1:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the **3RD SUNDAY** of every month.

Together these books make up the Scriptures. The unity of the Old and New Testaments flows from the revealed unity of God's loving plan to save us. The books of the Old Testament include the Pentateuch, historical books, the books of the Prophets, and the Wisdom books. The New Testament contains the four Gospels, the Acts of the Apostles, and letters from St. Paul and other Apostles and concludes with the Book of Revelation.
