By diocesan regulation, parents must be **REGISTERED FOR THREE MONTHS** and together with the sponsors must attend **ONE** instruction in preparation for Baptism. Sponsors **MUST** be registered and active in a parish; married in the Catholic Church; and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST SATURDAY** of every month - 1:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the **3RD SUNDAY** of every month.

#### **DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM**

**FOR ADULTS:** 1. Why must Revelation be transmitted? God

"[wills everyone] to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth:" that is, of Christ Jesus. Christ must be proclaimed to all nations and individuals, so that this revelation may reach the ends of the earth. (CCC, no.74, citing 1 Tm 2:4; cf. Jn 14:6)

2. How is Apostolic Tradition linked to Apostolic Succession?

Christ the Lord...commanded the apostles to preach the Gospel. (CCC, no. 75, citing DV, no. 7: cf. Mt 28:19-20: Mk 16:15) In order that the full and living Gospel might always be preserved in the Church the apostles left bishops as their successors. They gave them "their own positions of teaching authority." (CCC, no. 77, citing DV, no. 7; St. Irenaeus *Adv. Haeres*).

3. Why does the Church venerate Scripture? The Church has always venerated the Scriptures as she venerates the Lord's Body. She never ceases to present to the faithful the bread of life, taken from the one table of God's Word and Christ's Body. In Sacred Scripture, the Church constantly finds her nourishment and her strength. (CCC, nos. 103-104; cf. DV, no. 21)
