Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date.

BAPTISMS

Parents must arrange the Baptism of their child in advance in the parish office, and all necessary paperwork must be completed by the 1st week of the month. By diocesan regulation, parents must be **REGISTERED FOR THREE MONTHS** and together with the sponsors must attend **ONE** instruction in preparation for Baptism. Sponsors **MUST** be registered and active in a parish; married in the Catholic Church; and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST SATURDAY** of every month - 1:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the **3RD SUNDAY** of every month.

DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR

ADULTS: How was Jesus able to save all of us? No man, not even the holiest, was ever able to take on himself the sins of all men and offer himself as a sacrifice for all. The existence in Christ of the divine person of the Son, who at once surpasses and embraces all human persons and constitutes Himself as Head of all mankind, makes possible His redemptive sacrifice for all. (CCC, no. 616)

Why did Jesus die on the Cross? Jesus came "to give His life as a ransom for many" (Mt 20:28). By His loving obedience to the Father, He fulfilled the atoning mission of the suffering Servant, "he was pierced for our offenses, crushed for our sins...by His stripes we were healed" (Is 53:5) (cf. CCC, nos. 599-618).
