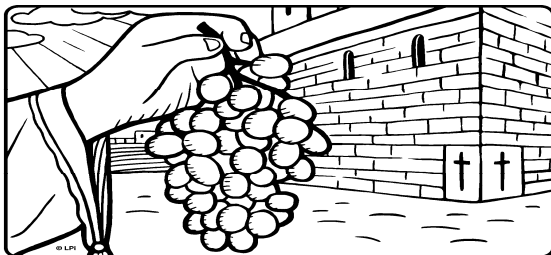
CONFESSIONS - SATURDAY FROM 4:00 - 5:00 P.M. OR BY APPOINTMENT

BAPTISMS

Parents must arrange the Baptism of their child in advance in the
parish office, and all necessary paperwork must be completed by the
1st week of the month. By diocesan regulation, parents must be
REGISTERED FOR THREE MONTHS and together with the
sponsors must attend **ONE** instruction in preparation for Baptism.
Sponsors **MUST** be registered and active in a parish; married in the
Catholic Church; and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic
Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST SATURDAY** of every
month - 1:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the
3RD SUNDAY of every month.

DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: What are images of the Holy Spirit in Scripture? In Scripture, some of the images of the Holy Spirit are fire, cloud and light, seal, hand finger of God and dove. (cf. CC, nos. 696-701). How are water and anointing, symbols of the Holy Spirit? *Water*:...signifies the Holy Spirit's action in Baptism, since after the invocation of the Holy Spirit it becomes the efficacious sacramental sign of new birth. (CCC, no. 694). *Anointing*: The...anointing with oil also signifies the Holy Spirit...In Christian initiation, anointing is the sacramental sign of Confirmation, called "chrismation" in the Churches of the East. (CCC, no. 695).
