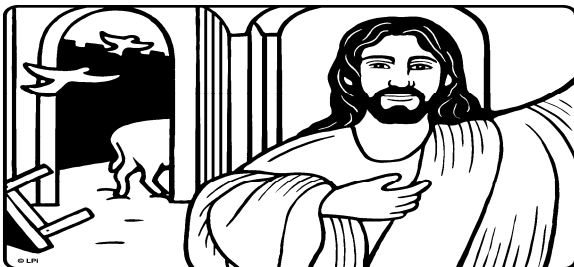
CONFESSIONS - SATURDAY FROM 4:00 - 5:00 P.M. OR BY APPOINTMENT

BAPTISMS

Parents must arrange the Baptism of their child in advance in the parish office, and all necessary paperwork must be completed by the 1st week of the month. Parents and Sponsors must attend ONE instruction class in preparation for Baptism. Sponsors MUST be registered and active in a parish; married in the Catholic Church; and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the 1ST SATURDAY of every month - 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the 3RD SUNDAY of every month.

DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR

ADULTS: To be a Christian Steward: A summary of the U.S. Bishops' Pastoral letter on stewardship: "As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied graces: (1 Pt 4:10). What identifies steward? Safeguarding material and human resources and using them responsibly are one answer; so is generously giving of your time, talent and treasure. But being a Christian steward means more. As Christian stewards, we receive God's gifts gratefully, cultivate them responsibly, share them lovingly in justice with others, and return them with increase to the Lord. *Disciples as Stewards:* A follower of our Lord Jesus Christ. As members of the Church, Jesus calls us to be disciples. This has astonishing implications: • Mature disciples make a conscious decision to follow Jesus, no matter what the cost. • Christian disciples experience conversion - life-shaping changes of mind and heart and commit themselves to the Lord. • Christian stewards respond in a particular way to the call to be a disciple. Stewardship has the power to shape and mold our understanding of our lives and the way in which we love. Jesus' disciples, as Christian stewards, recognize God as the origin of life, the giver of freedom, and the source of all things. We are grateful for the gifts we have received and are eager to use them to show our love for God and for one another. We look to the life and teaching of Jesus for guidance in living as Christian stewards.
