PLEASE NOTE: JANUARY - POVERTY IN AMERICA

AWARENESS MONTH: Today, 36.5 million Americans—an 1 in 6 children (that's 17.4 percent of all American children)- are living below the poverty line. They live in families who are of necessity making hard choices between food, health care, heat and rent. Our economic downturn has left many people out of work and struggling to hang on. Local food pantries, shelters and social agencies are seeing a marked increase in need. To bring attention to this national crisis, the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) has designated January as; "Poverty in American Awareness Month." JANUARY 4TH - 10TH; NATIONAL MIGRATION WEEK: Issues such as immigration, refugees, forced migration, human trafficking are the focus of the USCCB Department of Migration and Refugee Services. *Renewing Hope, Seeking Justice* is the theme of 2009's National Migration Week, which "reminds us of our obligation to bring hope to the hopeless and to seek justice for those who are easily exploited," said Bishop John C. Wester of Salt Lake City, chair of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops Committee on Migration, in a letter sent to every parish and across the country. The observance began over 25 years ago by the Bishops, to be a moment for Catholics to take stock of the wide diversity of the Church and the ministries serving them and to learn more about the issues surrounding migration phenomena.

DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR

ADULTS: Epiphany is a Christian feast celebrating the arrival of the Magi (the Three Kings) in Bethlehem, the baptism of Jesus Christ, and other miracles. Epiphany ends on the twelfth day of Christmas. The name Jesus means "God saves." The child born of the Virgin Mary is called Jesus, "for He will save his people from their sins" (Mt 1:21): "there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).
