SANCTITY OF LIFE AWARENESS AND UNITY DAY, JANUARY 22, 2009: The three Diocese of New Mexico mark the 36th Anniversary of the Supreme Court decision Roe v. Wade legalizing abortion with a Sanctity of Life Awareness and Unity Day on January 22, 2009. The day includes a series of events including a Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Francis in Santa Fe, a rally at the statehouse and visiting with legislators. The three Bishops of our State, Archbishop Michael J. Sheehan (Archbishop of Santa Fe), Bishop Ramirez (Diocese of Las Cruces) and Bishop Thomas J. Olmsted (Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Gallup) will be concelebrating Mass at noon. Participants are asked to bring baby items such as diapers, blankets, bottles, etc. to be collected at the Mass and distributed to organizations in the three Diocese that provide support to expectant mothers in need. Immediately following Mass, at approximately 1:30 p.m., there will be a procession from the Basilica to the Roundhouse and a rally at the Roundhouse at 2:00 p.m. led by Allen Sanchez, Director of the New Mexico Conference of Catholic Bishops. Other groups will host other events surrounding the Mass.

DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: Why is suicide morally wrong? Suicide contradicts the natural inclination of the human being to preserve and perpetuate his life. It is gravely contrary to the just love of self. It likewise offends the love of neighbor because it unjustly breaks the ties of solidarity with family, nation, and the human societies to which we continue to have obligations. Suicide is contrary to love for the living God. (CCC, no 2281) What are the roots of war? Injustice, excessive economic or social inequalities, envy, distrust, and pride raging among men and nations constantly threaten peace and cause wars...Insofar as men are sinners, the threat of war hangs over them and will so continue until Christ comes again; but insofar as they can vanquish sin by coming together in charity, violence itself will be vanquished.
