DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: RCIA STEPS: For adults who have not yet been baptized, the RCIA has three major liturgical rites: Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens; Election or Enrollment of Names, and Celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation. The celebration of initiation is followed by a post baptismal catechesis, or *Mystagogy*. (For those already baptized, there are rites appropriate for their journey into full communion with the Catholic Church. These are sometimes celebrated separately from the catechumens, and sometimes in a combined rite with the catechumens). The process begins with the Precatechumenate, in which the person shows initial faith in Jesus Christ and the Church. This is a time of inquiry and the exploration of the beginnings of faith.
