DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR

ADULTS: RCIA STEPS (continued): After the person has been given a fundamental understanding of the Gospel and has decided to take the first step to become a member of the Church, the person is brought into the Catechumenate at the Rite of Acceptance. The period of the Catechumenate is a time for exploring the teachings of the faith in a deeper and more systematic manner within the context of worship and prayer. At Sunday Mass, the catechumens with their catechists are often dismissed after the homily for further, prayerful study of the Scripture readings for the day. This period concludes with the Rite of Election or Enrollment of Names, which takes place on the First Sunday of Lent. This rite is celebrated by the bishop or his delegate, usually at the cathedral of the diocese. The catechumen's suitability and resolve to be initiated into the sacramental life of the Church is supported by the testimony of their sponsors and catechists. After this the catechumens become known as the Elect. (Will continue next week).
