Sponsors **MUST** be registered and active in a parish; married in the Catholic Church; and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST SATURDAY** of every month - 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the **3RD SUNDAY** of every month.

LENTEN REGULATIONS: Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday, are to abstain from meat on **ALL FRIDAYS** of Lent, including Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition to abstaining from meat, if you have celebrated your 18th birthday and until the age of 60, you are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound by this regulation may eat one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain one's strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

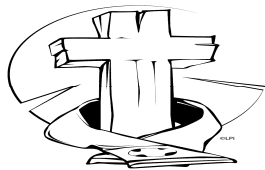

DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR

ADULTS: 1. Why are the rites of Baptism so helpful for understanding this Sacrament? The meaning and grace of the Sacrament of Baptism are clearly seen in the rites of its celebration. By following the gestures and words of this celebration with attentive participation, the faithful are initiated into the riches this sacrament signifies and actually brings about in each newly baptized person. 2. Why is sin possible after Baptism? Certain temporal consequences of sin remain in the baptized, such as suffering, illness, death and such frailties inherent in life as weaknesses of character...as well as an inclination to sin that Tradition calls *concupiscence.* (CCC, no. 1264)
