DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: 1. Why should we adore the true God alone? We adore God because He is God and deserving of our adoration. Human life finds its unity in the adoration of the one God. "Idolatry is a perversion of man's innate religious sense" (CCC, no. 2114). The Commandment to worship God alone integrates man and saves him from an endless disintegration. 2. What is the link between God's love and the Commandments? God has loved us first. The love of the One God is recalled in the first of the "ten words." The commandments then make explicit the response of love that man is called to give to His God. (CCC, no 2083)
