**FRANCISCAN FRIARS OF THE RENEWAL (CFR) TALK SERIES: "Living a Virtuous Life":** Fr. Mariusz Koch, CFR, will be guest homilist at Prince of Peace Catholic Community in Albuquerque, today, (Divine Mercy Sunday). Mass time: 5:00 p.m. Fr. Mariusz' homily will focus on "The Virtue of Mercy." He has served as a parish priest, pastor, Director of Vocations for the Archdiocese of Newark, and in Campus Ministry and Rector of the Collect Seminar at Seton Hall University. For eleven years, Fr. Mariusz has been a member of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal. His present responsibilities include the Mission Team, post-abortion ministry, spiritual direction, priest retreats, Formation Council for Friars in temporary vows, work with the homeless, Presbyteral Council of the Archdiocese of Newark, and spiritual directions for the seminarians at Immaculate Conception Seminary at Seton Hall University.

**MARRIAGE ENRICHMENT:** "*The Largely Hidden and Almost Unknown Holiness in Marriage*" is the theme of the **Marriage Enrichment Conference** on Saturday, April 25th, at the Immaculate Heart of Mary Retreat Conference Center in Santa Fe. David M. **DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS:** **The Understanding of Marriage in Contemporary Society:** There are attempts by some in contemporary society to change the definition or understanding of what exactly constitutes marriage. Efforts to gain approval for and acceptance of same-sex unions as marriages are examples. While the Church clearly teaches that discrimination against any group of people is wrong, efforts to make cohabitation, domestic partnerships, same-sex unions, and polygamous unions equal to marriage are misguided and also wrong. The Church and her members need to continue to be a strong and clear voice in protecting an understanding of marriage, which is rooted in natural law and revealed in God's law.
