**DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR**

**ADULTS:** 1. Why is the family called "the domestic Church?" The Christian home is the place where the children receive the first proclamation of the faith. For this reason the family is rightfully called "the domestic church," a community of grace and prayer, a school of human virtues and of Christian charity. (CCC, no.1666)

2. what is essential in the consent of those to be married? The parties to a marriage covenant are a baptized man and woman, free to contract marriage, who freely express their consent; "to be free" means: -not being under constraint; -not impeded by any natural or ecclesiastical law. (CCC, no 1625)
