DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: 1. How are we created in the image of God? It is in Christ, "the image of the invisible God" (Col 1:15) that man has been created "in the image and likeness" of the Creator. By virtue of his soul and his spiritual powers of intellect and will, man is endowed with freedom, an "outstanding manifestation of the divine image" (GS, no. 17). (CCC, nos. 1701, 1705). 2. What is freedom? Freedom is the power to act or not to act, and so to perform deliberate acts of one's own. Freedom attains perfection in its acts when directed toward God, the sovereign Good... The right to the exercise of freedom, especially in religious and moral matters, is an inalienable requirement of the dignity of man. But the exercise of freedom does not entail the putative right to say or do anything. (CCC, nos 1744, 1747)
