DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: *The Church as Mystery: The Church is essentially both human and divine, visible but endowed with invisible realities, zealous in action and dedicated to contemplation. CCC, no 771*
The Church is a holy mystery because of her origin in the Holy Trinity and her mission to be the Sacrament of Salvation (the sign and instrument of God's plan to unite all under Christ). The Holy Trinity brought the Church into being. The Father called the Church into existence. The Son established the Church. The Holy Spirit filled the Church with power and wisdom at Pentecost. The Holy Trinity abides with the Church always, creatively and providentially. The Church, empowered by the Holy Spirit, brings Christ's salvation to the world. She is the instrument of God's universal call to holiness. At the same time, the Church is made up of a sinful people. Yet despite the personal sinfulness of her members, the Church remains holy by the presence of Jesus and the Holy Spirit who permeates her.
