**DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS:** A basic duty every human person owes to God is regular worship. Because of this, and because of the basic longing each person has for God, a fundamental human right is the right to worship freely. No one should be prohibited from a free exercise of their faith, either public or in private, and no one should ever be forced to worship in a manner that violates their beliefs and convictions. Because freedom of religion and worship is such an important and fundamental right, government needs to enact and enforce laws that respect and protect this right (cf. CCC, nos. 2105-2109).
