YEAR OF THE PRIEST: Holy Father Benedict XVI has declared and begun the Year for Priests with prayer and great hopes for the priesthood of the Catholic Church in the future. Archbishop Michael J. Sheehan is asking every parish in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe to gather for Holy Hour on Monday, August 3rd, at 7:00 p.m., to pray for priests throughout the world and to pray especially for the priests who are in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. Our parish will begin with Mass at 6:30 p.m. followed by Holy Hour at 7:00 p.m. We invite the parish as a whole to come and join us.

Refreshments will be served in the parish hall following Holy Hour. A plenary indulgence for all the faithful has been established for the 1st Thursday of each month during the year, provided you fulfill these requirements. Attend Mass, have made a good confession within a week, have offered prayers to Jesus Christ for priest of the Church and any other good work done that day. A partial indulgence can be obtained by devoutly reciting the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be, five times each or any other approved prayer in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (e.g. The Rosary, The Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus), to obtain that priests be preserved in purity and holiness of life.

Classes for those students entering a Sacramental Class (Confirmation & 1st Holy Communion), if you have not registered yet, please do so as soon as possible, classes will begin the week of August 16th.
