DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS: How is prayer connected to Christian life? Prayer and *Christian life are inseparable, for they concern the same love and the same renunciation, proceeding from love; the same filial and loving conformity with the Father's plan of love; the same transforming union in the Holy Spirit who conforms us more and more to Christ Jesus; the same love for all men, the love with which Jesus has loved us.* (CCC, no. 2745) What should we remember when our prayers seem unanswered? Do not be troubled if you do not receive immediately from God what you ask Him; for He desires to do something even greater for you, while you cling to Him in prayer. (CCC, no. 2737, citing Evagrius Ponticus, *De Oratione*, 34: PG 79, 1173). Filial trust is put to the test when we feel that our prayer is not always heard. The Gospel invites us to ask ourselves about the conformity of our prayer to the desire of the Spirit. (CCC, no. 2756)
