**DID YOU KNOW? FROM THE CATHOLIC CATECHISM FOR ADULTS:** 1. How does the Church honor Mary? The Church rightly honors the Blessed Virgin with special devotion. "From the earliest times the Blessed Virgin is honored under the title Mother of God, whose protection the faithful take refuge together in all their perils and needs...This cult...differs essentially from the cult of adoration, which is offered equally to the Incarnate Word and to the Father and the Holy Spirit, and it is most favorable to it" (LG, no. 66). The liturgical feasts dedicated to the Mother of God and Marian prayers, such as the rosary, and "epitome of the whole Gospel," express the devotion to the Virgin Mary, (CCC, no 971) 2. Does Mary intercede on our behalf? This motherhood of Mary in the order of grace continues uninterrupted...Taken up into heaven she did not lay aside this saving office, but by her manifold intercession continues to bring us the gifts of eternal salvation.
