

## **SECOND ANNUAL TRAIN – THE – TRAINERS 2001 SEMINAR IN KERRVILLE**

Kerrville's Y O Ranch Hotel Resort will be the site of something special on February 2 and 3, 2001. On those days, the District Leadership Development Chairmen will be attending in a training seminar. This participation will assist the Chairmen in preparing district and club leaders to successfully carry out their duties in 2001-2002. Sessions will start at 2:00 p.m. on Friday and conclude at approximately 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.

The District Leadership Development Chairman, or Leadership Trainer, is responsible for the provision of training for club secretaries, treasurers, vice presidents, presidents, cabinet officers and Lions in any other positions of leadership. Some of the trainers will be new to their position and may be looking for all the assistance available. This seminar will certainly help them. Some trainers will be repeating the job, perhaps for the umpteenth time, and may feel comfortable with their knowledge of what is required. These Trainers should also be involved at Kerrville. One focus of the training will be Lions Clubs International's promotion of leadership working as a team in the areas of Leadership, Extension and Membership (LEM Team Concept). Each seminar enrollee will receive additional information, including an agenda, approximately January 1.
