

**TEXAS LIONS LEADERSHIP FORUM**  
**Set For March 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> 2001**  
**in Austin**

Austin's J. J. Pickle Research Center will be the site of the Texas Lions Leadership Forum on March 16 and 17, 2001. This seminar, intended to provide training for Lions statewide, will be the first of its type in several years. When a state dues increase was proposed about one year ago, one of the most requested and promised results of that increase was to be an expansion of Leadership Training. This will be a major impact in that area.

Registration for the seminar will occur starting at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, with the first major session starting at 3:00 p.m. Presentations will include two large group sessions, with outstanding motivational speakers, and several smaller group breakout sessions. Intended as training for Lions who have not yet served as District Governors, the content will focus on providing increased leadership qualities at many levels rather than teaching the administrative particulars of specific jobs. Like the LCI Forum, it is intended that this seminar will explore content which may enhance the Lions' club, personal and even business lives.

A registration form is included in this newsletter. The registration fee of \$35 will cover the cost of a dinner and luncheon, and the use of the facility. Lions attending, or their clubs, will be responsible for their transportation, lodging and additional meals. The number of Lions allowed to participate will be limited by facility size. Acceptance of registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
