From I-410 (NE), exit Harry Wurzbach and travel south. **If you have a Department of Defense Permit & ID you can enter the post at the corner of Dickman Rd and Harry Wurzbach** Turn RIGHT and then LEFT into the parking lot of Building 592, Billeting; the start point for the walk.

FOR THOSE ONLY WITH A PICTURE ID: From I-35 North or South bound, exit Walters turn west and travel Walters to Scott Road. Turn left on Schofield Rd. and proceed to Dickmann Road and turn right. Continue on Dickman Road to Building 592, Billeting the start point for the walk. Parking is adjacent to the building

NOTE: Access to Fort Sam Houston through all gates is limited to individuals possessing a Department of Defense identification card. Other individuals may gain access to the Post through the Walters Street gate only with a picture identification. Sorry for the inconvenience.

The TEXAS WANDERERS of Fort Sam Houston, AVA-006 an organization which promotes family sports is the sponsor of this walk

event. This event *has been sanctioned* by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

The trail is 10Km (6.2) miles) and is rated level 1. It is on flat terrain and is suitable for strollers and wheel chairs. The walk is through Fort Sam Houston which is a **NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK** and has a collection of historic structures and sites which is second to none. Pets on leashes are permitted **except** inside the Quadrangle, where there are numerous deer, fowl and rabbits which run free in this small enclosed area. The route is not marked. Each participant will receive a map and detailed instructions.

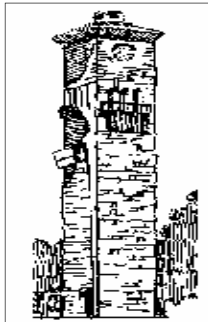
Everyone is welcome however children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Everyone can walk, jog, or run at their own pace and all participants must sign a waiver and carry a validated start card. Groups of 10 or more should

write or call in advance.

Start at Bldg. 592, Fort Sam Houston Billeting on Dickman Road, Fort Sam Houston, TX 78234. Parking is available at the parking lot adjacent to the building. The Start Box is located in the entrance way on your **RIGHT**. You may start daily anytime from dawn to three hours before dusk. **YOU MUST CARRY YOUR PHOTO ID AT ALL TIMES DURING THE WALK WHILE ON FORT SAM HOUSTON and walk only during daylight hours.**

There is no pre-registration. Register by following the instructions in the box. **Registration**-\$3.00 fee per person for IVV credit in the Distance and Event books. CREDIT ONLY and there is no "A" award. Previous year awards are available as "B" awards for a \$4.00 fee per person and includes IVV credit. If no credit is desired, the event is free. Each person must register and begin with a start card. **ALL CARDS MUST BE TURNED IN AT THE END OF THE WALK.** Event will be held regardless of weather. Do not walk in severe weather. Fees are nonrefundable.

There are two check points. Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and in the areas of each check point. Water, vending machines and restrooms are available at various locations along the route.

This event counts towards IVV achievement awards. Participants are reminded to bring their IVV books and IVV insert cards will be available. Two IVV credits per year are now available for this event, one during each of the following time frames:

**1 January – 30 June 2003
and**

1 July – 31 December 2003

You may participate for Distance credit without limit. \$2.00 must be paid each time you walk if you want credit. You may walk 20K on the same card the same day for one fee.
